In the studied area, there are a total of 25 accommodation units. They have wide classification with different services, different number of rooms and beds.

MATERIAL AND METHODS

For research has been applied a 25 questions quizzed, applied to 25 tourist accommodation units, namely 24 for pensions owners and a manger of the hotel.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION


With regard to the category and classification of the accommodation units, the units are divided as follows:

In the area under study, is evident predominance of accommodation establishments and hostel, argued, in part, by the fact that there are units agto of specific rural tourism accommodation. In the early 1990s, appeared in documnetele agto official statistics included in the same category with farmhouses and inns urban tourist attractions. After 1996, the complexes have been identified as a category in its own right.

It is obvious that there is a direct proportionality between the average number of additional services offered by the accommodation and the category of the establishment: 1. Margaret units provide, in principle, a green space or Tv viewing opportunities, while in the case of the 4-star hotel comes with a much wider range of additional services.

Overall, in the Vad-Borod area there are a number of 213 rooms accommodation to tourists, which sums up 561 places. It is obvious ascenden trend of demand of accommodation in the area, considering that in the year 2003, there were 48 beds, distributed in 21 rooms.



Services offered by the accommodation units

Amenities at their disposal establishments vary according to the category to which it belongs. According to the responses, all units have TV, radio, toilet with shower and offer the possibility of extra bed. It is noted that a private bathroom for each room have just 14 units (56%). Fixed telephony and cable television lies at 23 of the units; GSM mobile signal is available for all 25 units. Prices for accommodation vary from one unit to another, depending on the degree of comfort and service. The lowest rates are recorded in the area, where a night Şuncuiuş accommodation/room starts from 40 RON. Also in this area are recorded and the highest prices, price per night/room in a 4 start at 180 RON

CONCLUSIONS

To highlight the possibilities for improvement of tourism and rural tourism in the Vad-Borod area was initiated a research based on the survey with questionnaire method. The questionnaire, which included 25 questions was administered a number of 24 owners of pensions and an owner of 4 star hotel. As a result, information processing were dislodged the following conclusions:

- most of the guesthouses were built in the last 3-5 years, which shows that it is a young and lively resorts development;

- of the 25 property owners questioned, 8% are members of professional associations, to 20 of the 25 respondents said that the condition of infrastructure and the provision of utilities affects very much work;

- most units (92%) had fewer than 10 employees and the training of employees, even if it is an academic one, it is not in the field of tourism;

- there are a number of factors that are considered having a strong influence on the activity of tourism units/agritourism units from Vad-Borod area: financial resources, law, bureaucracy, infrastructure and promotion.
